- Initiate and participate in public, media, and local school outreach activities.
- Participate in the daily operation, administration and further development of the department's strategy and education programmes.

Skills

An MSc in Pharmacy or equivalent and a PhD degree are required for the position. It is expected that the successful candidate will bridge-build towards relevant scientific disciplines of interdisciplinary nature within the department and beyond. The ability to communicate clearly, and creativity in teaching – preferably in Danish - is a prerequisite. For non-Danish speaking applicants, it is expected that

teaching in Danish or another Scandinavian language will be possible after two years of appointment.
